Position Summary

Responsible for researching, implementing, and monitoring network design plans and facility utilization. Supports transport systems, trunking, radio, carrier, access circuits, and switching facilities under the direction of the Lead Network Engineer. Provides analysis and recommendations on network performance and deployment. This role supports Ponderosa and Table Top Telephone projects and requires frequent travel, including air travel and extended stays.

Key Responsibilities

- Monitor and analyze network transport and subscriber facilities (fiber, data, radio, trunking, ADSL) and augment as needed.
- Prepare network facility augmentation plans and accurate cost estimates.
- Provision central office and remote equipment; engineer COE and transmission work orders.
- Ensure compliance with RUS specifications and prepare required RUS forms and contracts.
- Coordinate work orders with Outside Plant, Central Office, and Customer Support teams.
- Inspect projects in progress and upon completion for compliance and accuracy.
- Prepare project status reports, contracts, and documentation for FCC/State/RUS inquiries.
- Interface with customers, contractors, and agencies regarding facility requirements and project activities.
- Attend pre-construction meetings, perform acceptance testing, and document results.
- Travel frequently to Table Top and Ponderosa exchanges (including extended stays and air travel).
